COACHES AND CLUBS INFORMATION SHEET – 2016-2017

- Abuse of Game Officials by team officials or spectators WILL NOT be tolerated and will be dealt with at the District or Provincial level.
- Discipline for players will be dealt with initially at the District level. Team official and any other discipline will be dealt with at the district level.
- UISA Line-Up & Game Report Forms will be used for all 11-aside games. Forms to be supplied by the HOME team. A Form must be properly and completely filled out by both teams BEFORE handing to referee at the start of game.
- ID cards are MANDATORY for all 11-aside League and Cup games. All players, including "permitted" players, and team officials must have ID cards by October 1st of the current season. Please ensure all cards have a "17" sticker. Players or team officials without ID cards may still participate in league games only and may be subject to sanctioning by the District.
- Teams that use authorized "permit" players must identify them by placing a "P" beside their name on the UISA game sheet. Unauthorized permit players, team officials subject to sanctions
- Game results must be entered on the UISA website AND reported by both teams to their Club by Monday at 5:00pm
- Fields should have technical areas and dotted spectator lines, at a minimum of 2 meters from the sideline.
- Teams and spectators shall be on opposite sides of the field for all games. No coaching is permitted from the spectator side of field, and coaches are asked to help enforce this. Referees will be told to report offending teams. Team officials must control their technical areas.
- A player receiving three (3) yellow cards in a playing season, including Cup Play up to the DISTRICT level, must automatically sit out their next game.
- A player receiving a RED card or a team official reported for misconduct must automatically sit out their next game.
- While under suspension, the suspended player or team official's name must still appear on the team list with SUSPENDED written in place of ID #. A person under suspension is not allowed to be on the team side of field.
- Suspension fulfillment only counts in League and Cup games.
- While under suspension, the person is not allowed to participate in ANY soccer activities i.e. games, practices, training sessions or any other activities related to soccer, including exhibition or friendly games, unless written permission is received from Upper Island Discipline Committee.
